The event's special guest speaker, Dr. John Bruchalski, MD, is a former abortionist who is now a dedicated prolife doctor. Several years ago, after a terrible misjudgment in the delivery room, Dr. Bruchalski realized that with every pregnant woman he attends, there are two patients — the mother and the unborn child. In addition to this discovery, two remarkable spiritual experiences deepened his understanding of the kind of man he became and one he was called to be. His book entitled "Two Patients" tells of his conversion story. After several years of practicing obstetrics, Dr. Bruchalski established Divine Mercy Care, a charitable nonprofit foundation in 2000. He now devotes much of his time traveling throughout the country promoting Christ centered medicine and educating the next generation of prolife medical providers.
